

By offering an exceptional level of service, along with efficient, high-quality vessels, we consistently deliver a higher standard.



Ocean shipping is our business. **Fednav International Ltd. (FIL)**, our maritime freight division, transports over 30 million tonnes of mainly dry-bulk, including agricultural products, sugar, fertilizers, and industrial minerals as well as steel and other general cargo on our fleet of 120 owned and chartered vessels.

The FIL fleet is comprised of Handysize, Supramax, and Ultramax bulk carriers. Renowned for Arctic trading expertise, boast the world's largest fleet of ice-class bulk vessels.

Specializing for six decades in the St. Lawrence-Great Lakes Seaway System and in the ice-covered waters of the Arctic, today, FIL's wider focus is on the transportation of bulk and breakbulk on a worldwide basis.




TRANSATLANTIC'S #1 CHOICE FOR BREAKBULK SHIPMENTS TO NORTH AMERICA'S HEARTLAND

Since 1959, **Fednav Atlantic Lakes Line (FALLine)** has operated a continuous scheduled cargo liner service from North European to St. Lawrence and Great Lakes ports.

Focusing on flexible scheduling to meet specific customer needs, FALLine offers an average of 50 to 60 sailings each year, transporting a mix of steel products such as coils, beams, wire rods, slabs, billets as well as project and breakbulk general cargoes.





DELIVERING SOLUTIONS IN THE ARCTIC

Having participated in every major shipping project in the Canadian Arctic since the late 1950s, **Fednav's Arctic Operations and Projects** know how to deliver innovative and effective solutions for that challenging region.

The company owns and operates both 31,500-tonne MV *Umiak I* and MV *Nunavik*, the most powerful icebreaking bulk carriers of their kind as well as the MV *Arvik I*, an oil-bulk-ore icebreaking vessel powerful enough to navigate unescorted through ice-covered waters.

HELPING YOU NAVIGATE THROUGH ICE

Fednav Ice Services, a subsidiary of Fednav Limited, provides support to vessels for safe and efficient navigation in ice, assists Fednav's operations in the Arctic and the Baltic regions, and produces sea ice assessments and marine accessibility studies for current and projected shipping operations in ice-infested waters.

Additionally, Fednav is the developer and distributor of IceNav™, a shipboard navigation system used by vessels operating in ice-covered waters worldwide. This system allows mariners to access satellite imagery and up-to-date ice and weather information. It also incorporates an enhanced marine radar for the detection of sea ice.

Fednav's terminal operations division, **Federal Marine Terminals, Inc. (FMT)**, operates 13 facilities located in the Great Lakes, the Canadian Arctic, the US East Coast, and in the Gulf of Mexico.


Recognized as an industry leader, FMT has been operating stevedoring facilities for over 55 years.
